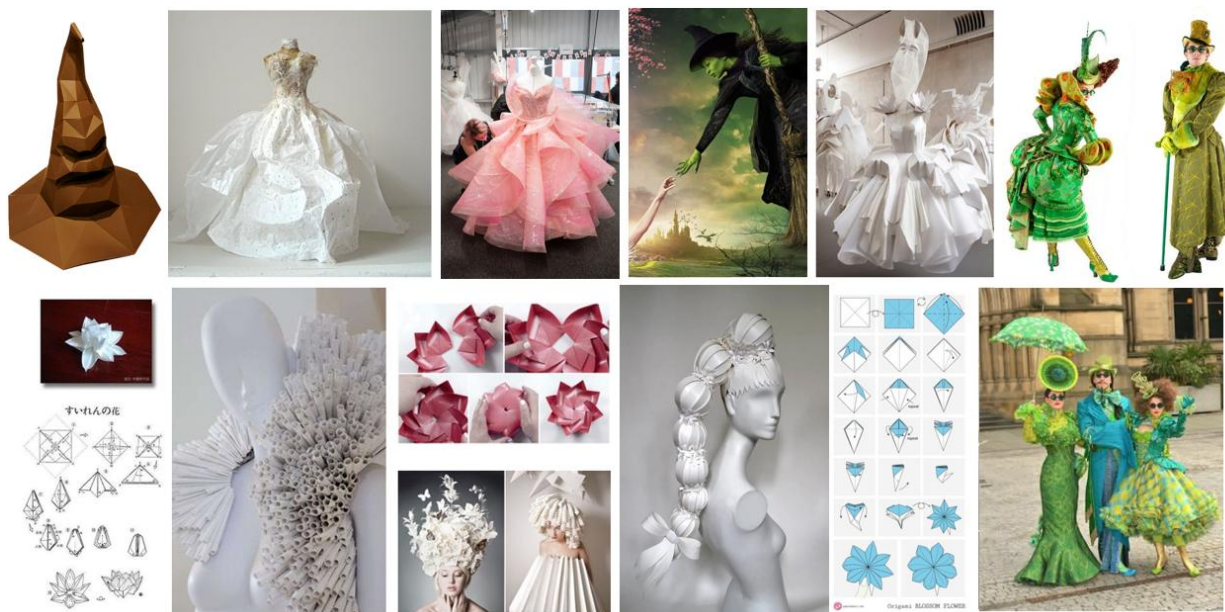
INITIAL ASSIGNMENT

YOUR RESEARCH

At the start of the course you will complete a short 2-week paper project, in which you will meet and work with your peers. This year we will be working with Willow Wood Hospice to promote their [Charity 5k Walk](#) by producing Wicked Themed Paper Creations.

To prepare ideas for this, research “Paper Fashion”, “Paper Art” or “Origami Tutorials” and create a moodboard of rich visuals to help inspire the design of a wearable piece of art made from paper. As the theme is Wicked you will also need to include inspiration for characters from the musical or film – think Elphaba, Glinda, Fiyero or even the Wizard of Oz!

Make sure to choose and include a **diverse range of images and ideas.**



YOUR OPINION

Choose a paper outcome or character's costume from your moodboard that really inspires you. **Include an image and write a statement** to go with it about what inspires you using the questions below. Be as descriptive as possible!

- Describe the item: What are the key design features? How has the artist manipulated paper in the design? What effect do these have?
- What caught your eye about the design and made it stand out to you? What about it is clever and why?
- What do you think the artist was inspired by? What does it remind you of?
- What ideas or elements could you take from it to design your own wearable outcome?

YOUR SAMPLES



Design with repetition is very pleasing to the eye, like this example here with repeated elements around the necks/shoulders.

Using ideas from your moodboard have a go different paper folding tutorials to create samples that could be repeated across a wearable design inspired by Wicked.

When you are confident with them, make 3 examples in different scales and sizes – **please use plain white paper** – you will use these in your first lessons here at Ashton Sixth Form College.
