 Marks for study leave, placement etc. will count positively

They are only learning when they are here...

- The duration and speed of level 3 study means any absence from college will impact their learning.
- Holidays in term time must be avoided and will not be authorised by the college – we take a very dim view of this.
- Our ambition is to have 100% attendance wherever possible, but be no lower than 94% overall as a sixth form.
